TennCare is Tennessee's managed care Medicaid program which provides health insurance coverage to certain groups of low-income individuals such as pregnant women, children, parents or caretaker relatives of minor children, older adults, and adults with disabilities.

# **TennCare- Behavioral Health Services**

- TennCare is Tennessee's Medicaid program
  - Eligible groups (all have different income limits) include:
    - Children under 21
    - Women who are pregnant
    - Parents of a minor child
    - SSI recipients
    - Individuals who need treatment for breast or cervical cancer
    - Individuals who live in NF or qualify for LTSS
- Approximately 1.7M Tennesseans are TennCare recipients

# TennCare- Summary

#### Quality Improvements

- Serving Tennesseans through Delivery System Transformation:
  - 89,245 members in Health Link
  - 778,249 in Patient-Centered Medical Homes
  - Covering 48 episodes of care
- Overall, the number of TennCare new, acute opioid users has declined by 58% since 2015. The largest decrease occurred following the implementation of new TennCare opioid benefit limits.
- Throughout 2021, 356 high-quality providers provided opioid use disorder treatment and recovery services to 15,000 members through TennCare's dedicated medication assistant treatment network.
- TennCare's Preferred Drug List compliance in 2021 is an industry-leading 94.84%.
- From FY20 to FY21, the statewide EPSDT screening rates for TennCare infants improved from 93% to 97%.

## TennCare's Managed Care Model

TennCare's managed care model means TennCare and CoverKids contract with health insurance plans also known as managed care organizations or MCOs. A health plan coordinates care for TennCare members and maintains a network of providers like doctors, hospitals, specialists, pediatricians, and nursing homes.

#### About Managed Care Model

Division of **TennCare** 

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- Strategies include negotiated rates, network optimization, insurer care coordination, and prior authorization for certain medications and services.
- Integrated care increases efficiencies, reduces cost shifting, and promotes more appropriate utilization of services.
- TennCare pays the health plans a Per Member Per Month (PMPM) rate which is similar to a health insurance premium. The health plans pay the providers for services delivered to members.

# Tennessee Health Link- Care Coordination

The primary objective of Tennessee Health Link is to coordinate health care services for TennCare members with the highest behavioral health needs.
 Each Tennessee Health Link organization is a team of professionals associated with a mental health clinic or other behavioral health provider who provides whole person, patient-centered, coordinated care for an assigned panel of members with behavioral health conditions. Members who would benefit from Tennessee Health Link will be identified based on diagnosis, health care utilization patterns, or functional need.

## Key Principles

- Ensure access to a range of physical and behavioral health related supports aligned with level of need
- Foster joint decision making across health providers
- Instill awareness of interaction of behavioral and physical health needs
- Expected sources of value included appropriateness of care setting, choice of behavioral health care providers, referrals to high value providers, and medical management
- Improved access to patient specific information
- Increased resources and training to support optimal patient care
