

★ TENNESSEE TBI TRENDS

Among TBI patients **45 YEARS** or **OLDER**, **MOST INIURIES** occurred due to UNINTENTIONAL **FALLS**

Among TBI patients 44 YEARS or M YOUNGER, TOTAL **MOST INJURIES** occured due to MOTOR **VEHICLE CRASHES**

TBIs caused by UNINTENTIONAL FALLS were ** MOST COMMON in **FEMALE PATIENTS** 65 YEARS or OLDER

The number of TBIs resulting from **MOTOR VEHICLE CRASHES** was NEARLY in DOUBLE TIT (1.9 times) in MALE **PATIENTS** compared to female patients



HISPANIC patients had the **HIGHEST** number of WORK-RELATED INIURIES
